Re: Oppose SB 250, as amended May 28, 2009 – **NEW INFORMATION.**

Dear Assembly Member de Leon:

Statistics just released by the California Department of Public Health confirm that Los Angeles shelters killed over 21,000 more dogs in 2008 than in 2007 – the first year under mandatory spay/neuter ("MSN") laws. Mandatory spay/neuter laws have been touted by Animal Rights groups as the solution to animal shelter overcrowding. Based on these statistics, mandatory spay/neuter laws could be viewed as the "final solution" as the killing of dogs in Los Angeles takes on genocidal proportions.
